Steve Frice Memorial Scholarship

- The annual Clark / Cowlitz Farm Bureau scholarship is intended to encourage the higher education of our active voting members and their children.
- In 2017, a minimum of two \$500 scholarships will be awarded.
- Applicant must have *completed* two years as an active voting member in good standing and be current on dues, or be a dependent child of such a member.
- Clark Cowlitz Farm Bureau is a member-driven grass roots organization. To be eligible for this scholarship, member or applicant must have participated in at least 2 Farm Bureau general meetings or approved activities in the last 12 months, or at least 1 meeting per year for the last 3 years.

Examples of some acceptable activities include active participation in the following:

Washington Farm Bureau State Convention, Legislative Days, Membership Meetings, Membership Drive, Women's Leadership Committee, Annual Picnic.

- Personal interview may be required.
- Scholarship applications will be individually reviewed and candidates will be selected by the Scholarship Committee. Winning applicants will be notified when final decisions have been reached. Special consideration will be given to applicants who have been certified in approved Agricultural majors.
- Application and all supporting documentation must be received by April 30, 2017.
